Williams' voluminous and sometimes complicated writings are inspired by two big and simple notions. The first is that the law should be clear, consistent and accessible. The second is that law should be humane. Glanville Williams anticipated the modern conception of a general common law of obligations. As a utilitarian, he rejected rigid classifications. He focused on the purposes of legal rules rather than on formal categories.
