Overt ethical problems like bribery, theft, sabotage, collusion, etc. are clear for everyone to see and are generally considered reprehensible. However, business ethics can also involve much more than this. Remember that the business ethics definition above also mentioned â€œdeciding what's morally right or wrong when doing business.â€” Itâ€™s an active process, then, in which company owners and employees grapple with ethical dilemmas in business and decide which business practices they will and wonâ€™t engage in. It applies to all aspects of business conduct on behalf of both individuals and the entire company. Ethics are in some ways a branch of philosophy, in which the idealized perspective is both malleable and uncertain. However, some powerful examples of ethical frames are available to us from many different time periods.
