Post-modernism is the term used to suggest a reaction or response to modernism in the late twentieth century. So postmodernism can only be understood in relation to Modernism. At its core, Postmodernism rejects that which Modernism champions. While postmodernism seems very much like modernism in many ways, it differs from modernism in its attitude toward a lot of these trends. Modernism, for example, tends to present a fragmented view of human subjectivity and history, but presents that fragmentation as something tragic, something to be lamented and mourned as a loss. Postmoder... As a kind of productive knowledge, techne is often defined by its close association with rationality and instrumentality. One of the obvious difficulties in developing a general account of art since 1945 is its closeness to the contemporary period. In the highly influential writings of the American art critic Clement Greenberg , the most significant of which were published between 1939 and 1965, the term was loaded with specific historical and evaluative connotations . This latter notion of "postmodernism," as a cultural sea change, has been expounded most eloquently by the American literary theorist Fredric Jameson in his book Postmodernism; or, The Cultural Logic of Late Capitalism (1991), but it is not necessary to define it in any detail here.
