One of the obvious difficulties in developing a general account of art since 1945 is its closeness to the contemporary period.Â In the highly influential writings of the American art critic Clement Greenberg , the most significant of which were published between 1939 and 1965, the term was loaded with specific historical and evaluative connotations .Â This latter notion of â€œpostmodernism,â€ as a cultural sea change, has been expounded most eloquently by the American literary theorist Fredric Jameson in his book Postmodernism; or, The Cultural Logic of Late Capitalism (1991), but it is not necessary to define it in any detail here.
