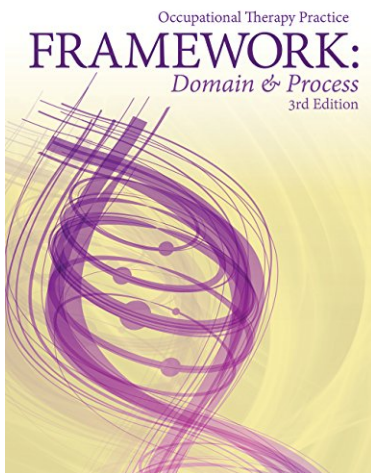

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## Description:

As occupational therapy celebrates its centennial in 2017, attention returns to the profession's founding belief in the value of therapeutic occupations as a way to remediate illness and maintain health. The founders emphasized the importance of establishing a therapeutic relationship with each client and designing an intervention plan based on the knowledge about a client's context and environment, values, goals, and needs. Using today's lexicon, the profession's founders proposed a vision for the profession that was occupation based, client centered, and evidence based--the vision articulated in the third edition of the *Occupational Therapy Practice Framework*:

## *Domain and Process.*

The domain includes environment, client factors, such as the individual's motivation, health status, and status of performing occupational tasks. The domain looks at the contextual picture to help the occupational therapist understand how to diagnose and treat the patient. Once the practitioner has identified the occupations in which the client would like to engage, the practitioner analyzes performance skills—including motor, process, communication/interaction skills, emotional regulation, sensory, perceptual, and cognitive skills—required to complete the occupation. Performance skills are small units of performance. Within this domain of practice, occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants consider the repertoire of occupations in which the client engages, the performance skills and patterns the client uses, the contexts influencing engagement, the features and demands of the activity, and the client's body functions and structures.
