A Missional community is a group of people, about the size of an extended family, who are united through Christian community around a common service and witness to a particular neighborhood or network of relationships. The Missional Community doesn't exist for anything less than making disciples of Jesus among these networks or neighborhoods. The participants of missional communities find their primary identity of "church" within the missional community, rather than a larger worship service or small Missional communities are intentional webs of relationships bound together for the express purpose of bringing to light the Kingdom of God to those outside the faith. One focus, however, is not just being "sent" into the culture, but also why we're sent and what we do in our sent-ness. Going back to Genesis 12, we're sent to be a "blessing," and a blessing means the tangible touch of God in real life.
Maybe the most simplistic way to define a missional community is as a "missionary" community. Just like you might live and focus your time and energy in a foreign culture, learning, listening, and responding to the needs you see around you, so it is with a missional community here in your back yard.
